

Frontier's Construction Team Hits a Home Run with 30 Day Challenge!

As a performance measure, Frontier recently set a goal for its construction team to complete a multi-section home in 30 days. When you figure in all the variables, it sounds like an impossible task to complete. But our guys were up for the challenge, and excited to have a specific target to aim at.



Prior to this set, our crew had completed 24 homes, with an average completion time of 87 days. The team finished this house in 26 calendar days, which is 61 days quicker than the average time.

The first mountain was proving to everyone that the goal was achievable and that

everyone must be on board in order to achieve this accomplishment. After everyone on the team agreed that it was an attainable goal, they were able to work together to map out a calendar which detailed every event that must occur, including scheduling of contractors and what must be complete by when. With the thought in the back of their minds that if they “missed a beat, they would miss their deadline,” the crew knew that they were held accountable for meeting goals and deadlines the same as everyone else.

“It is very important for our crew to meet this goal on a continuous basis, because for every day they are working on a job, it adds additional cost to the house,” said Josh Trent, Communities and Design Manager for Frontier.
