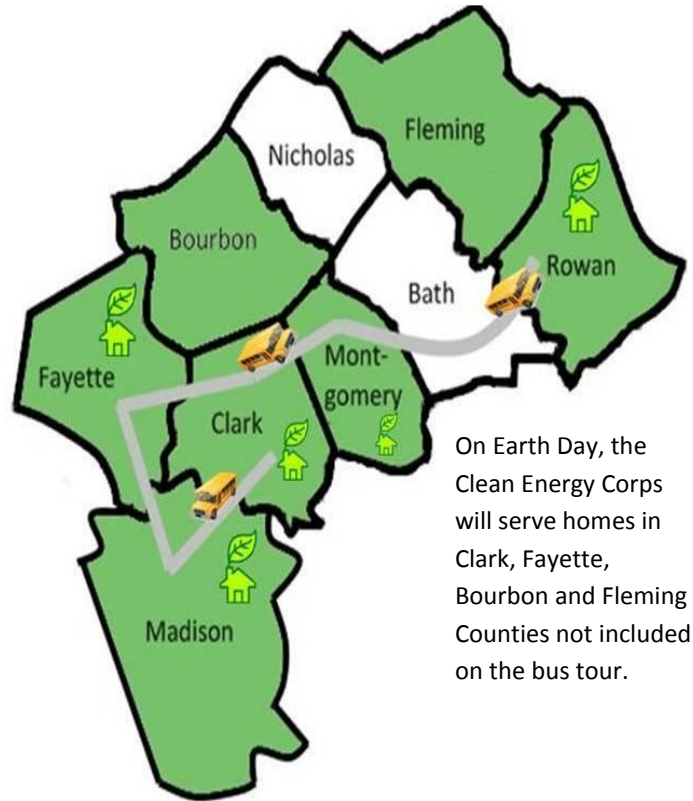
## Clean Energy Hybrid Bus Tour:

### Earth Day, April 22

On Earth Day, more than a dozen modest-income homes in seven counties will receive extensive energy efficiency improvements, as part of **Kentucky's Clean Energy Corps**, a program launched by Governor Beshear to reduce energy costs, protect the environment, and create thousands of "green collar" jobs.

The **Clean Energy Hybrid Bus Tour** will feature a Louisville TARC hybrid bus filled with volunteers and distinguished guests, such as the Governor and First Lady, at some stops. The tour will reach five counties on Earth Day.

Each tour site will host an **Open House**, where the public can witness home improvements and take home "**Clean Energy Kits**," filled with energy-efficient devices and user-friendly tips on how to save energy in their own homes.



On Earth Day, the Clean Energy Corps will serve homes in Clark, Fayette, Bourbon and Fleming Counties not included on the bus tour.
